

Certificate of RoHS III Compliance

RoHS 3 (EU Directive 2015/863) extends the original RoHS Directive by adding Category 11 (catch-all) products and including four new restricted substances, specifically phthalates. These substances are primarily used as plasticizers in insulation materials and are listed as Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) under the REACH regulation.

The expanded list of restricted substances under RoHS 3 is as follows:

- Cadmium (0.01 %)
- Lead (0.1 %)
- Mercury (0.1 %)
- Hexavalent chromium (0.1 %)
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) (0.1 %)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) (0.1 %)
- Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) (0.1 %)
- Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP) (0.1 %)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) (0.1 %)
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) (0.1 %)

Based on the ingredient lists (or Material Safety Data Sheets, MSDS) provided by our suppliers, we certify that the substances listed above are not used in the manufacturing of Blue-White products and will not be used in the future. Any trace levels of these substances that may be present as impurities are expected to be within the regulatory threshold limits.

This certification applies to:

- A. All products originally manufactured and released for sale on or after July 1, 2006.
- B. All refurbished, reconditioned, or otherwise returned products with an original manufacture and sale date of July 1, 2006, or later.

To the best of our knowledge, all products manufactured and shipped by Blue-White Industries as of July 1, 2006, comply with the European Union RoHS Directive 2015/863 for the Reduction of Hazardous Substances.
